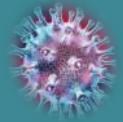


Staff Update

Vaccinations

Our initial rollout of vaccination appointments is complete, everyone should now have had the opportunity of their first vaccination. If you have not been contacted, please talk to your Manager urgently.

I apologise if you have been contacted multiple times about seemingly the same thing. Early vaccine rollout was predictably a little chaotic, with slots opened suddenly and made available to a host of organisations (not just us), with the ensuing scramble to book slots and release people from rosters. At this stage we are confirming lists and data – who has, who's waiting, who hasn't – so please bear with us if we call or email more than once.

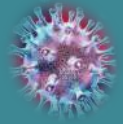
If you are about to go for a vaccination appointment, please remember to take you eligibility letter and ID with you – the vaccination centre may turn you away without these. Eligibility letters have been distributed by both email and post, and if you are unsure again please do talk to your Manager.

Data and evidence continue to grow about the protection offered by single dose vaccination, alongside the effect of vaccination on transmission. At the moment the best advice I have heard is, first dose may not stop you getting the virus, but it will almost certainly keep you out of hospital if you do.

We are so very lucky to have been offered such early appointment slots, and while I know some people have been a little anxious about the vaccine, this is truly the way forward and with any luck the way out of the craziness that has been the last year or so. If you have declined the vaccine, or are still thinking about it, I urge you to consider very carefully the information available, and the pros and cons of vaccination. Any of you colleagues will be happy to talk it through with you.
